"Our website is a vital tool for our department to communicate with businesses and the public about the different ways we're working to grow New Mexico's economy."

The BRC is a one-stop-shop resource for all New Mexico businesses who need to know the steps to take to register and license their company with the state, and be successful. The BRC includes a searchable directory of business development programs and services. It also features NMEDD's business service programs: the Job Training Incentive Program, finance development, ISO 9000 training, the statewide business retention and expansion (BRE) program, international trade, and the Office of Business Advocacy.

The New Mexico State Data Center offers a searchable database of available commercial properties; county and tribal data profiles; and a comparison of New Mexico data with the other 49 states. NMEDD is the lead agency in the Census Bureau's SDC program and, through an agreement with the Bureau, provides easy access to census data at a variety of geographic levels.
