The New Mexico Film Office Announces that “Grow” has filmed in New Mexico

Santa Fe, N.M. – The New Mexico State Film Office Director Todd Christensen announced today that the television series “Grow,” produced by Rocket Road Pictures, has completed filming in Santa Fe.

The production employed 30 New Mexico crew members, 3 New Mexico actors and 30 New Mexico background talent.

The television series is directed by Milad Avaz and produced by Avaz, Misam Avaz, and Daniel Cotroneo. The Avaz Brothers broke the mold with their feature debut “Mens Vi Lever,” which was a breakout box office hit in Denmark in 2017, and received five nominations at the Danish Film Academy Awards. They recently wrapped principal photography on their latest feature “Collision” which stars Nikolaj Lie Kaas (“Angels & Demons”), Rasmus Bjerg and Nicolas Bro.

Starring Jonathan Harboe and Caspar Phillipson (“Mission Impossible: Fallout,” “Jackie”), “Grow” is the story of a young stock broker, Adam (26), who delves into the dark past of his recently deceased father and is quickly consumed. It isn’t long before the lines of Adam’s structured world are blurred by a hunger for power and quick recognition in the Danish drug market.
