



San Miguel County has seen significant growth in its matched taxable gross receipts (MTGR) over the last eight quarters, as seen in Chart 1. From quarter two FY18 to quarter one FY20 MTGR has grown by 28%. San Miguel County has seen a \$26M increase in the Construction industry from Q1 FY19 to Q1 FY20 as seen on Table 1, on the next page. Over that same time period the entire county MTGR has grown by \$30M or 34%. Table 1 also shows one industry, with -100% growth or no MTGR in Q1 FY20.

This may be due to the county's smaller size and thus fewer companies within each industry. The few companies working in these industries may be late in filing, resulting in no MTGR being reported for the period. In this case, the missing MTGR is expected to be included in the next period.





Gross Receipts Tax (GRT) revenue collections rose significantly in the first quarter of FY20, as seen in Chart 4. Annual GRT collections have leveled off since the high of FY16, but have an upward trend from FY10 to FY19. Since FY10, annual GRT collections have grown by \$2M or 94%.


HB6, PASSED IN 2019, MADE WIDESPREAD TAX CHANGES WITHIN NEW MEXICO. ONE NOTABLE CHANGE IS THE CONVERSION TO DESTINATION-BASED SOURCING THAT WILL BEGIN AFTER A TWO YEAR DELAY. DURING THIS DELAY LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WILL RECEIVE A DISTRIBUTION THAT IS A PORTION OF \$2M EACH MONTH. THE PORTION DISTRIBUTED WILL BE BASED ON WHAT THE POPULATION OF EACH COUNTY IS TO THE TOTAL POPULATION OF ALL COUNTIES, AS PER THE MOST RECENT DECENNIAL CENSUS.
