The New Mexico Cash Assistance Fund

Provides one-time cash assistance to New Mexicans, with priority to those who have been adversely impacted by the Calf Canyon and Hermit's Peak wildfires. Focus will be on the following counties:

First Strides Grant Program

This program seeks to fund, mentor, and champion trailblazing women business owners by awarding 10 businesses each with a \$10,000 grant. **Deadline: December 31.**

Intro to WESST Loan Program Workshop

WESST's loan program focuses on building relationships through critical business consulting, training, technical assistance, and other support services to their loan recipients. Their small business loan rates and fees are extremely competitive, and often the lowest available. Learn more about their lending program at this workshop! **December 7**, **2022**.

Competitive Pay for Professionals (CPP)

The state will provide funding for any eligible childcare employee (e.g., teachers, cooks, bus drivers, administrative staff, etc.) with an active ECECD-issued or approved background clearance, if the organization attests that staff will receive a \$3/hour wage increase.

AmeriCorps improves lives, strengthens communities, and fosters civic engagement through service and volunteering.

AmeriCorps is committed to working on a Nation-to-Nation basis with Native Nations and upholding the federal government's Tribal trust responsibility.

AmeriCorps planning grants provide support to a grant recipient to develop an AmeriCorps program that will engage AmeriCorps members in implementing evidence-based interventions to solve community problems.

Community Resources

Youth Engagement, Education, and Employment

Provides work and education opportunities for youth (defined as ages 16-30 inclusive, and up to age 35 for veterans) participants in the areas of natural and cultural resource conservation, development, and scientific research. **Deadline: September 10, 2023**

Bipartisan Infrastructure Law FAA Contract Tower (FCT) Competitive Grant Program

Makes annual grants available to eligible airports for airport-owned airport traffic control tower projects that address the aging infrastructure of the nation's airports. **Deadline: December 6.**

Affordable Connectivity Outreach Grant Program (ACP)

The ACP Outreach Grant Program seeks to increase awareness of, and participation in, the ACP among eligible households. **Deadline: January 9, 2023.**

National Farmworker Jobs Program Youth Grants

Eligible applicants are current National Farmworker Jobs Program (NFJP) grant recipients who are serving Migrant Seasonal Farmworker (MSFW) youth. **Deadline: December 22**.

Meat and Poultry Processing Expansion Program (MPILP)

USDA Rural Development provides grant funding to nonprofit intermediary lenders who finance, or plan to finance, the startup, expansion, operation of slaughter, or other processing of meat and poultry. **Deadline: December 31.**

USDA Regional Food Business Centers

USDA Agricultural Marketing Service program offers funds for coordination, technical assistance, and capacity building support to small and midsized food and farm businesses, with the goal of creating a more resilient, diverse, and competitive food system. **Deadline: December 15 (extended).**

Community Based Grant

Community Based Grants are available for nonprofit organizations and/or fiscally sponsored projects that increase access to, and build awareness for, STEM careers and advance STEM training opportunities for underrepresented communities. Awards are available up to \$5,000. **Deadline: December 1.**
