## NM SBIR Awardees FY20

[LoadPath LLC](#) delivers mechanical, structural, and thermal technologies for satellite and space launch applications. This award will allow them to move toward commercialization of their product to be able to deliver thermal control subsystem technologies that enable future high-power small spacecraft. LoadPath was also a recent recipient of state funds through the Job Training Incentive Program, which will allow them to hire and train new employees into their high-technology, high-wage positions. *Update Feb. 2023: Company has been acquired by Redwire.*

[VisionQuest Biomedical LLC](#) develops and deploys imaging technologies to give access to the millions of individuals in the U.S. and worldwide with limited or no access to healthcare, especially as related to diabetes and eyecare. Funds will go toward commercialization of new retinol image technology which will allow for better identification of malarial biomarkers in eyes to diagnose cerebral malaria, a disease that is most common in tropical regions of the world such as Africa.

[X-Bow Launch Systems](#) recently moved their primary operations from Auburn, CA to Albuquerque, NM. An additive manufacturer of rocket propellant, X-Bow award will be used to aid in its development of additively manufactured solid propellant technology with applications across many industries, including automotive airbag deployers and motors for small tactical applications to the largest rocket boosters.
