**Community Resources** 

### NATIVE Act Tribal Tourism Cooperative Agreement

Provides funding for Tribes to conduct feasibility studies to help them make informed decisions about potential tourism projects. **Deadline: September 29.** 

### **Rural Healthcare Delivery Fund**

Defrays operating losses, including rural health care provider or rural health care facility startup costs incurred in providing new or expanded health services. **Deadline: October 6.** 

### **Energy Improvement in Rural or Remote Areas Fixed Award**

Provides financial investment, technical assistance, and other resources to advance clean energy demonstrations and energy solutions that benefit rural and remote communities. **Deadline: October 12.** 

### **Community Wildfire Defense Grant**

Assists at-risk local communities and Indian Tribes with mitigation planning to reduce the risk created by wildfires. **Deadline: October 3.** 

### **Conservation Innovation Grant (CIG)**

Program aims to stimulate the development and adoption of innovative conservation approaches and technologies in conjunction with agricultural production. Projects should lead to the transfer of conservation technologies, management systems, and innovative approaches (such as market-based systems) to agricultural producers through the development of technical manuals, guides, and practical instruction for the private sector. **Deadline: October 30.** 

### **Community Food Projects Competitive Grant Program**

Brings together stakeholders from distinct parts of the food system to foster understanding of national food security trends and how they might improve local food systems. Understanding that low-income individuals experience disproportionate access to healthy foods, projects should address food and nutrition security, particularly among our nation's most vulnerable populations. **Deadline: October 30.** 

### **Clean Communities Investment Accelerator**

A competitive program that will provide grants to 2–7 hub nonprofits that provide funding and technical assistance to specific industry networks of public, quasi-public, not-for-profit, and nonprofit community lenders, supporting the goal that every community in the country has access to the capital they need to deploy clean technology projects in their homes, small businesses, schools, and community institutions. These community lenders could include community development financial institutions (including Certified Native CDFIs), credit unions, green banks, housing finance agencies, minority depository institutions, and other types of lenders. **Deadline: October 12.** 

### **Outdoor Recreation Trails+ Grant**

Invests in conservation-minded shovel-ready projects that show demonstrable benefit to the local community, either by attracting/retaining residents or attracting visitors. The project must be open for public use (projects on Tribal lands do not have to be open to the public but should be open to Tribal members). **Deadline: Open until all funds are expended, apply early.** 

### Neighborhood Access and Equity Program

Supports economically disadvantaged or underserved communities in planning, capital construction activities, and regional partnerships that aim to restore community connectivity through the removal, retrofit, mitigation, or replacement of highways, roadways, or other infrastructure facilities that create barriers to mobility, access, or economic development. **Deadline: September 28.**
