3D Printing Technician Bootcamp

Offered through Santa Fe Community College, this 12-week intensive course trains participants in CAD design fundamentals and design for 3D printing, post processing, LEAN manufacturing, technical writing, and more. This program is tuition-free and provides a stipend. Classes start February 3, applications accepted now.

### **Rural Energy for America Program**

Provides guaranteed loan financing and grant funding for rural small businesses and agricultural producers to implement renewable energy systems or make energy efficiency improvements. **Deadline: March 31.** 

### **New Mexico Advanced Energy Award**

This state-funded grant offered through the Economic Development Department's Office of Strategy, Science & Technology funds proposals in advanced energy innovation and commercialization from New Mexico small businesses engaged in research and development.

The funds seek to assist early-stage companies developing a unique product with strong growth potential.

Application deadline: February 6, 2025 at 5pm MST.

### **Tribal Energy Development Capacity Grant**

Seeks to develop the Tribal management, organizational, and technical capacity needed to maximize the economic impact of energy resource development on Federally recognized Tribal land. **Deadline January 16, 2025.** 

### **Tribal Colleges and Universities Head Start Partnership Program Grants**

Provides competitive funding for Tribal colleges and universities for the purpose of establishing or enhancing partnerships with Head Start programs that effectively increase the number of qualified education staff working in American Indian Alaska Native Head Start and Early Head Start programs. **Deadline: January 21, 2025.** 

### Preserve Route 66 Legacy Business Grant Fund

Financial support to businesses to preserve historic places and spur economic development along the Route 66 corridor. **Deadline: January 23.** 

### Tribal Clean Energy Planning and Development Grant

Supports Tribal entities to conduct clean energy planning, comprehensively assess the feasibility and viability of deploying clean energy technology, or conduct clean energy design and development activities. **Deadline: January 23.** 

### **High Energy Cost Grants**

Assists energy providers in lowering costs for families and individuals in communities with extremely high per-household energy costs. **Deadline: February 28.** 

### Rural Health Care Services Outreach Program

Grant program supports organizations that promote and deliver rural health care services by strengthening local resources and capacity in rural communities. **Deadline: January 27.** 

### **Rural Business Development Grant**

Promotes economic development and job creation in rural areas by providing grant funding for either business opportunity grants or business enterprise grants to local/county/state governments, nonprofits, and Tribal entities. **Deadline: February 28, 2025.** 

### **Community Wildfire Defense Grant**

Grant supports communities in restoring and maintaining landscapes, creating fire-adapted communities, and improving wildfire responses. **Deadline: February 28.** 

#### Promoting Internet Needs of New Mexicans (PINON) Grant

Grants from \$25,000-\$500,000 to support subgrantees in enhancing their digital equity programs tailored for populations vulnerable to digital exclusion. Informational webinar Tuesday, January 21. **Deadline: March 21.**
