Honeycomb Credit Breakthrough Grant

\$10,000 small business grants. Deadline: April 11.

Value-Added Producer Grant

Assists agricultural producers in starting or expanding value-added activities related to processing and/or marketing. **Deadline: April 17.**



Community Wildfire Defense Grant

Grant supports communities in restoring and maintaining landscapes, creating fire-adapted communities, and improving wildfire responses. **Deadline: February 28.**

Rural Business Development Grant

Promotes economic development and job creation in rural areas by providing grant funding for either business opportunity grants or business enterprise grants to local, county, and state governments, nonprofits, and Tribal entities. **Deadline: February 28.**

Main Street Disaster and Resilience Toolkit

Downloadable toolkit to help you plan for, prepare for, and recover from natural disasters in your community. **Free webinar on March 6.**

Santa Fe Community Foundation Spring Grant Cycle

Accepting proposals from organizations serving Santa Fe, Mora, Rio Arriba, and San Miguel Counties. **Deadline: March 9.**

Cultural Properties Restoration Fund

Up to \$250,000 grants to state agencies and other political subdivisions to fund historic preservation efforts. Guidance webinar on February 26. **Deadline: March 18.**

NMDA Healthy Soil Program

Provides grants to local government entities with proven land management to support healthy soil to implement projects that support at least one of the five soil health principles: keeping soil covered; minimizing soil disturbance on cropland and minimizing external inputs; maximizing biodiversity; maintaining a living root; integrating animals into land management, including grazing animals, birds, beneficial insects or keystone species, such as earthworms. **Deadline March 19**.

Promoting Internet Needs of New Mexicans (PINON) Grant

Grants from \$25,000-\$500,000 to support subgrantees in enhancing their digital equity programs tailored for populations vulnerable to digital exclusion. **Deadline: March 21.**

Connectivity to Declared Disaster Areas Grant

Infrastructure grants for broadband deployment to unserved and underserved communities impacted by environmental disasters, including wildfires and floods. **Deadline: March 21.**

Albuquerque Community Foundation 2025 Annual Grant Cycle

Grants are available in all seven fields of interest:
