NMED River Stewardship Program Request for Proposals

The goal of the River Stewardship Program is to fund projects that enhance the natural functioning of New Mexico's streams and rivers by providing state funding to plan, design, and construct projects that improve surface water quality or river habitat. **Deadline: May 20.**

Outdoor Recreation Legacy Partnership Program

Improves parks, recreational opportunities, and conservation areas in urban underserved communities, consistent with the requirements of the LWCF Act. Projects must be in a community that is underserved or has a population of 25,000 or more in the 2020 Census. **Deadline: June 1.**

National Trust Preservation Fund

Supports ongoing preservation work by providing seed money for preservation projects. **Deadline: June 2.**
